



TAILOR RING

THE STYLING GUIDE

10 ways to restyle *what you already own.*

No sewing. No cutting. No pinning. No damage.
Every look below takes about sixty seconds.



Three steps. Then everything else *is just placement.*

01 Place the ring

Set a Tailor Ring against the OUTSIDE of your garment, right where you want the fabric to pull in.

02 Grab it from inside

Reach inside the garment and pinch the ring through the fabric, so the material wraps smoothly around it.

03 Wrap the band

Wind an elastic band around the wrapped ring a few times. The ring disappears inside. All anyone sees is a clean gather.

WHICH RING DO I USE?

3 inch: necklines and sleeves 4 inch: tees and tops
5 inch: dresses and skirts 6 inch: heavier fabrics

The bigger the ring, the more fabric it gathers. Two of each are in your kit, so experiment.

Four things worth knowing

Take it off before you wash it

The ring survives a wash if you forget, but your clothes are happier if you pull it out first.

If the fabric looks stretched

Spray a little water on it. It relaxes back to its original shape as it dries. Every time.

Skip the delicates

Everyday fabrics love this. Anything fragile or precious, leave alone.

Bands are reusable

Each one lasts several uses and you have a hundred. Run out and we will send more, free.



01

Knot For Everyone

The knotted tee, without the knot

DO THIS

Gather the front hem of a tee, off to one side, about where your hip is. Pull the excess through to the inside.

WHY IT WORKS

Why it beats a knot: no bulk, no crease down the front, and it works on shirts that are too short to actually tie.

02

Let Me V

Scoop neck to V-neck

DO THIS

Pinch the center of the neckline from the inside, about two inches below the collar. Use a 3 inch ring.

WHY IT WORKS

The scoop pulls down into a clean V. Best trick in the kit for making a basic tee look intentional.

03

Skirt The Rules

The asymmetric drape

DO THIS

Gather a flowing skirt at one side, mid-thigh. Use a 5 inch ring for real fabric movement.

WHY IT WORKS

Lifts the hem on one side and creates the diagonal line that makes a plain skirt look designed.

04

Take It In

The waist you actually have

DO THIS

Gather at the natural waist of a shift or slip dress, slightly off center. 5 inch ring.

WHY IT WORKS

This is the one that turns a boxy dress into an hourglass. The single highest-impact use of the ring.



05

Short Story

Shorten a hemline, no scissors

DO THIS

Gather the hem at one side thigh and pull the excess up and inside.

WHY IT WORKS

A midi becomes a mini for one night, then goes back to a midi. Nothing is cut, nothing is permanent.

06

Behind The Scenes

Fix a boxy back

DO THIS

Gather at the small of the back, dead center. The tightest fit of any placement.

WHY IT WORKS

Nobody sees it, everybody notices the silhouette. Works on button-downs, tees, and shift dresses.

07

Scarf Dress

A dress that was never a dress

DO THIS

Secure a large scarf at the center bust, then again at one hip. Two rings, two bands.

WHY IT WORKS

The party trick of the whole kit. No sewing, no cutting, and the scarf is still a scarf tomorrow.



08

Sleeve Note

Cap a long sleeve

DO THIS

Gather the sleeve fabric at the shoulder or mid-bicep with a 3 inch ring.

WHY IT WORKS

Turns a long sleeve into a flattering cap or a ruched three-quarter without touching the hem.

09

Blouson

Borrowed-shirt energy, on purpose

DO THIS

Gather at the center back waist of an oversized shirt, leaving the front loose.

WHY IT WORKS

Keeps the relaxed front you like while defining the back. The trick that makes oversized read chic, not sloppy.

10

Off Duty

Beyond the closet

DO THIS

Rings work on anything fabric: pillow covers, curtain tiebacks, fastening sheets and blankets together.

WHY IT WORKS

Melodie invented this for clothes. Customers keep finding uses she never planned. Show us yours: #TailorRing.



Stop dressing for the size tag. *Dress for you.*
